PART ONE: GOD'S PLAN FOR WORK

Genesis 2:15

Is this appropriate to emphasize diligence, especially in this place in guide?

Prayer Prompt:

Use the verses above to ponder.... Take a moment to consider the greatness of God's wonderful work. How is your work a gift to you and to others? How have you benefited from others' work? How have you seen the work of others benefit the world and God's kingdom?

PART TWO: CONFESSION – BROKENNESS OF WORK

Genesis 3:17-19

Prayer Prompt:

Use the verses above to ponder. Ask the Holy Spirit to reveal how sin causes our work to be a “problem”. What is our problem with work? Do you see areas of your life and work where you feel the “curse” the most? Diligence is not an invitation to busyness, but a way of seeking daily what the Lord wants us to do. Where and in what ways do you see yourself choosing busyness over diligently praying and serving Him with your work? Acknowledge these to the Lord and thank Him for His forgiveness.

Small Group Prayer - Groups of 5-6 gather together for a short time of prayer, remembering that silent prayer is welcome. (No pressure to pray aloud.)

PART THREE: THE GOSPEL BEARS FRUIT IN OUR WORK

Proverbs 16:9

"Commit your work to the LORD, and your plans will be established."

To commit your work to the Lord means to SEEK HIS GLORY in everything you do.

John 6:28-29

Then they said to him, "What must we do, to be doing the works of God?" Jesus answered them, "This is the work of God, that you believe in him whom he has sent."

Regardless of our vocation or daily duties, our real work, in this life, is to BELIEVE in Jesus Christ. The way we express this is through believing prayer. So the real work we do, day in and day out, is to pray. Prayer is our true vocation and everything else flows from it. The priority of our daily tasks should be PRAY, WORK, PRAY. To pray before, during, and after our work motivates us, encourages us, and keeps our hearts and minds directed toward God, even in the most difficult and trying days.

John 15:4, 5, 6-8

Abide in me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit by itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in me. I am the vine; you are the branches. Whoever abides in me and I in him, he it is that bears much fruit, for apart from me you can do nothing. ...By this my Father is glorified, that you bear much fruit and so prove to be my disciples.

Prayer Prompt:

Use the verses above to ponder What are some ways you can be intentional about committing your work to the Lord to bear fruit for the kingdom of God? What are some ways you can be intentional about trusting God to establish His plans? Ask God to give us hearts that desire to glorify Him above all else in our work.
