- Meet regularly for discipleship with girls one-on-one and in small groups
- Meet weekly with youth ministry staff
- Take a leadership role at The Edge junior high conference (June 17-21)
- Lead junior high activities during senior high mission trip (July 13-20)

12 Hours Per Week

- Weekly gatherings (two per week) 4 hours
- Spend time with junior high girls 3 hours
- Spend time with senior high girls 2 hours
- Meeting with ministry staff 1.5 hours
- Planning 1.5 hours
