Worship Team Support	Children ages third grade and above can serve in various ushering, greeting and hospitality opportunities each week.	
Nursery	Children ages fourth grade and older are eligible to serve as nursery volunteers in training. At age 14, they are eligible to officially be paid and work.	
AVPC Kids' Sunday School	Children ages third grade and older can serve as Sunday School coordinators, as they help set up and clean up for our weekly children's discipleship hour.	
Worship Center	Children ages fourth grade and older may serve as Worship Center helpers in training during the sermon portion of either the early or late service.	
Kitchen and Fellowship	Children ages third grade and above can serve in various roles during Fellowship Dinners and Brunches.	
Camp Solid Rock	Children ages fourth grade and above can serve as junior leaders at various stations and in tribes throughout the week.	
Buddy Ministry	Children ages third grade and older can serve as peer buddies for our friends with various unique needs.
