AVPC Family SERVES

Altadena has a vision: we aim to be a community (or as Brad says, “outpost”) of Christ’s coming kingdom, bringing hope to a broken world. We are one under the family of God, and as a family, we all must do the small, unseen duties to keep moving in a forward, positive direction.

Considering all our ministry initiatives, on any given Sunday it takes close to 70 volunteers to continue corporate worship as we know it. Some of those roles are seen, but most are unseen. When there are continual needs and gaps in the unseen areas, our forward movement slows and at times just stops.

Right now, our needs are outweighing current available resources. However, we have many new families and members who have not had the opportunity to experience serving in various capacities because they haven’t been here very long. We also have long-established members who may be looking for a different area in which to serve, but are not sure where to begin.

In an effort to help both groups (new and old) find a way to contribute to the life of the Church, for a season, we are returning to a revised form of membership service that was in place for many years at AVPC.

As a result, people who have taken the membership vows will be automatically added to our AVPC Family Serves Initiative and be given the opportunity to choose their preferred service area. However, because we understand there may be limitations of which we are not aware, they may “opt out” completely - no questions asked. Our hope is that the frequency of service will average one-to-two times during a six-month period.

Our AVPC Family Serves Initiative currently identifies four main areas of need which we have deemed as crucial - they are listed on the next page, with a short explanation of possible service assignments.

Beyond that, we do have other areas in which you may be interested in participating or perhaps investigate further, and those are included in this booklet as well.

Our hope is to see our younger families serving alongside our older families - both set towards the common goal of loving God and loving others, as we are transformed by His love. It is by God’s grace that we will be able to serve each other in a way that brings us closer together and closer to Him.

This booklet is designed with you in mind. It provides a list of the major ministries of AVPC, and ways in which you can get involved in those ministries. Here is how this booklet can be helpful to you.

- Step 1: We encourage you read through the rest of this book and to consider (a) where you would enjoy serving, and (b) where you think your gifts might best serve your church family.
- Step 2: Please mark those areas “TELL ME MORE” in which you would potentially like to serve. **YOU ARE NOT SIGNING UP BY CHECKING THE BOX.** You are simply indicating you would like for someone to give you more information about that ministry area.
- Step 3: Return this booklet to Anna or drop it off in the church office. Someone will be in contact with you.

If you have any questions, feel free to reach out to the contact person listed. They will be glad to help and give you more details. Also, feel free to take an extra copy to keep at home to use as a prayer guide for these ministries and their leadership.
