SMALL GROUPS AT AVPC

You can't be at Altadena long without hearing someone refer to the church as a covenant family. What does that mean? It means that in Christ, we have been adopted into God's family. Because of that, we get to experience life in a spiritual family of believers. One of the best ways to lean into this family is through small groups, and September is a great time to jump into one!

What is a small group? It's what it sounds like – a small group of people (roughly 8-14) coming together weekly to apply God's word and pray for one another in the context of a small "family" of believers.

Who can join a small group? Any adult, member or nonmember, single or married is welcome to join a small group.

When do small groups meet? Most groups meet on Sunday (5:00 to 6:30 PM) or Wednesday (6:15-8:00 PM). However, some groups gather on other days or nights. So, there are many meeting opportunities.

Where do small groups meet? Groups meet in homes or on the church campus.

# **CHILDREN'S MINISTRY**

This July, I had the gift of returning to serve with our youth missions team at Sacred Road Ministries for the fourth summer on the Yakama Tribe Reservation in White Swan, Washington. Over the course of the past four years, our family has developed friendships with people there, individuals we support in prayer and partner with in ministry. Likewise, they pray for us in the callings God has for us here in Alabama. It was an honor to witness our AVPC seniors leading in ministry – as interns, in worship, on the work sites. I kept thinking that the character and qualities they were demonstrating by God's grace were first nurtured in their home and Altadena's children's ministry under Mrs. Betty. That is where their exposure to missions and God's Word began. What a beautiful joy to see the budding fruits of God's faithfulness and the diligence of those who steadfastly showed up and loved. One of the phrases you will hear regarding our children's ministry is that we are "rooting our covenant children for future flourishing." We pray our intentional efforts will yield our covenant children to be like the tree in Psalm 1, "that yields fruit in its season, and its leaf does not wither." We are praying for them to be plantings of the Lord's, oaks of righteousness for the display of His splendor as it says in Isaiah 61:3. Results like this do not simply happen. They demand God's abundant grace, favor and mercy, but they also require a commitment to our covenant vows as members of Altadena Valley – that we will partner with families in prayer, nurture, and discipleship for the children God has planted within our church body. This endeavor is futile with a lone Children's Ministry; it demands an army of believers who seek to serve, disciple and intercede for the families and covenant children of our church.
